Key Findings

- Expert quantification of medicine needs is vital yet often lacking
- Type of staff and expertise for quantification differs from that for procurement
- Constant flow through of medicine procurement staff is everywhere a source of concern
- No single and ideal model for medicines procurement
- Duplication of efforts and procedures is commonly encountered
