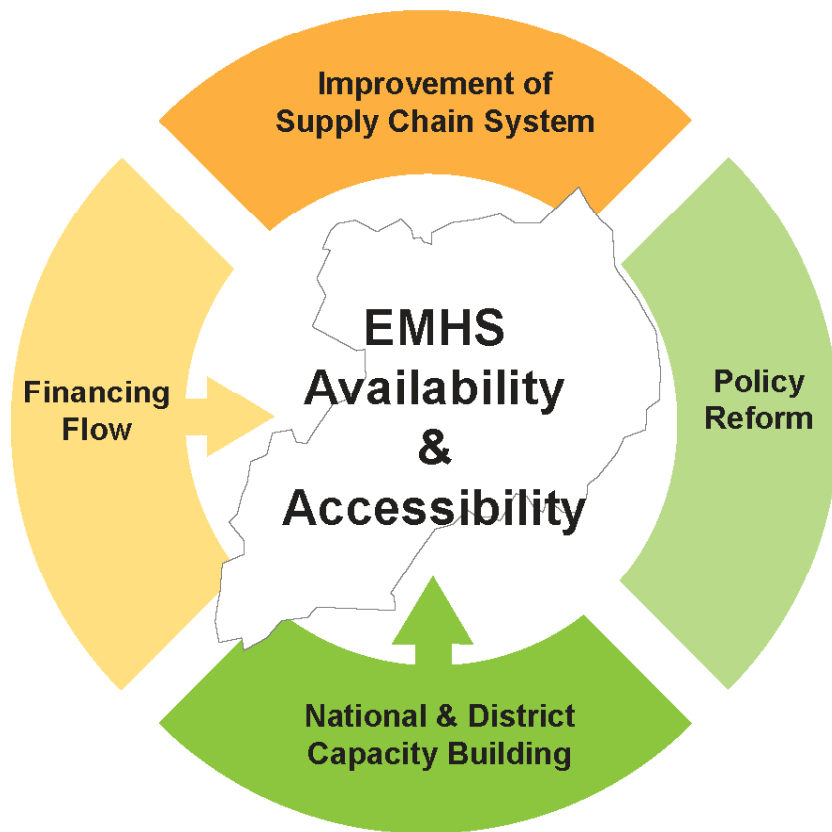

Uganda SURE Program and Objectives

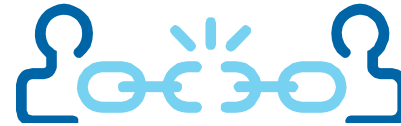


- USAID funded

 - New ways to ensure affordability (Policy Options Analysis)

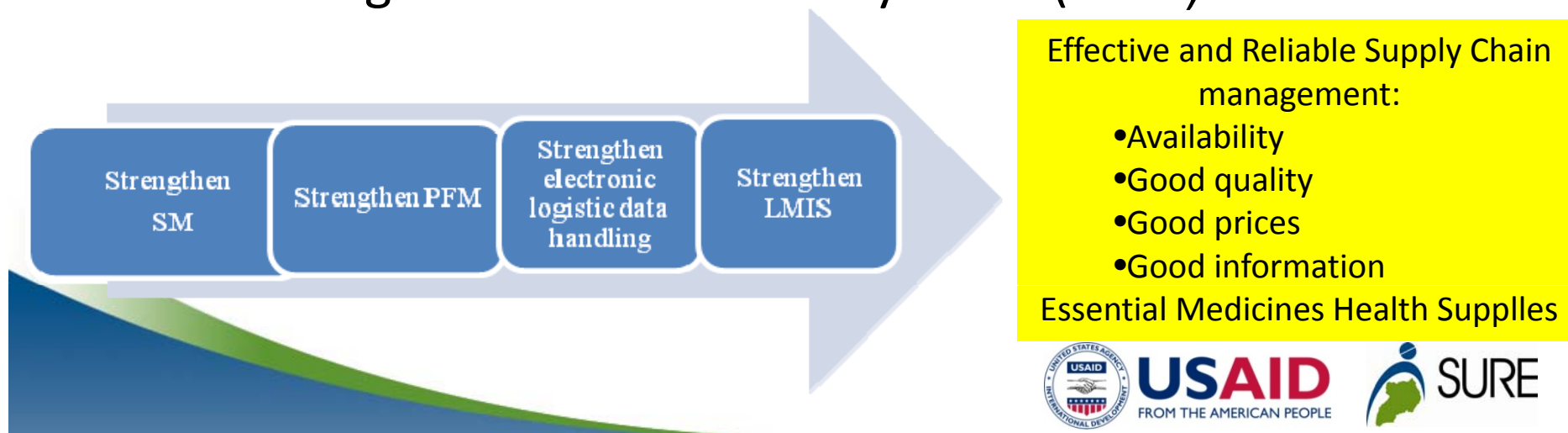

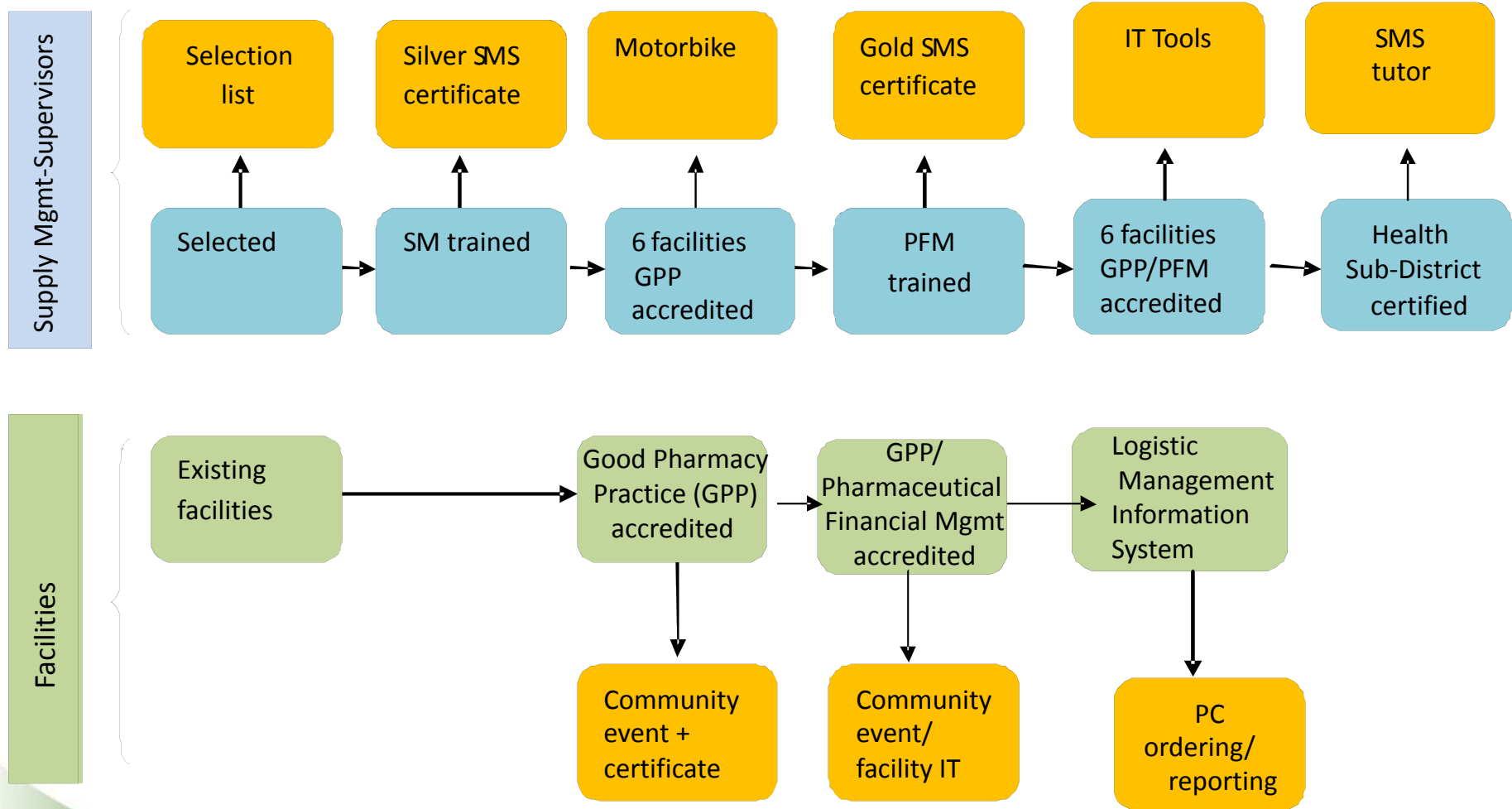


Capacity Building at the Facility Level—

 - Implementing new technologies/logistics management information systems (LMIS)



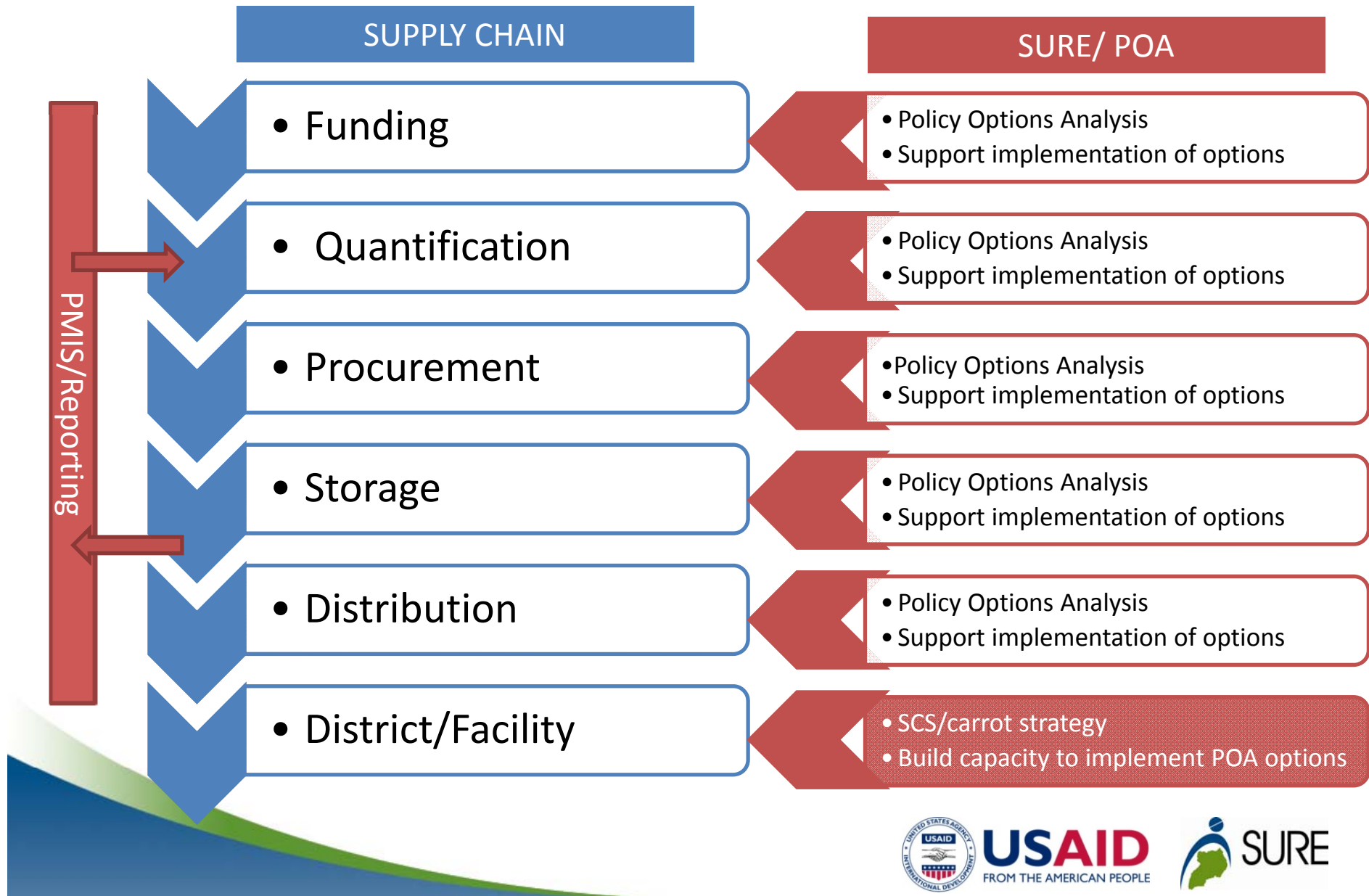
Carrot Scheme

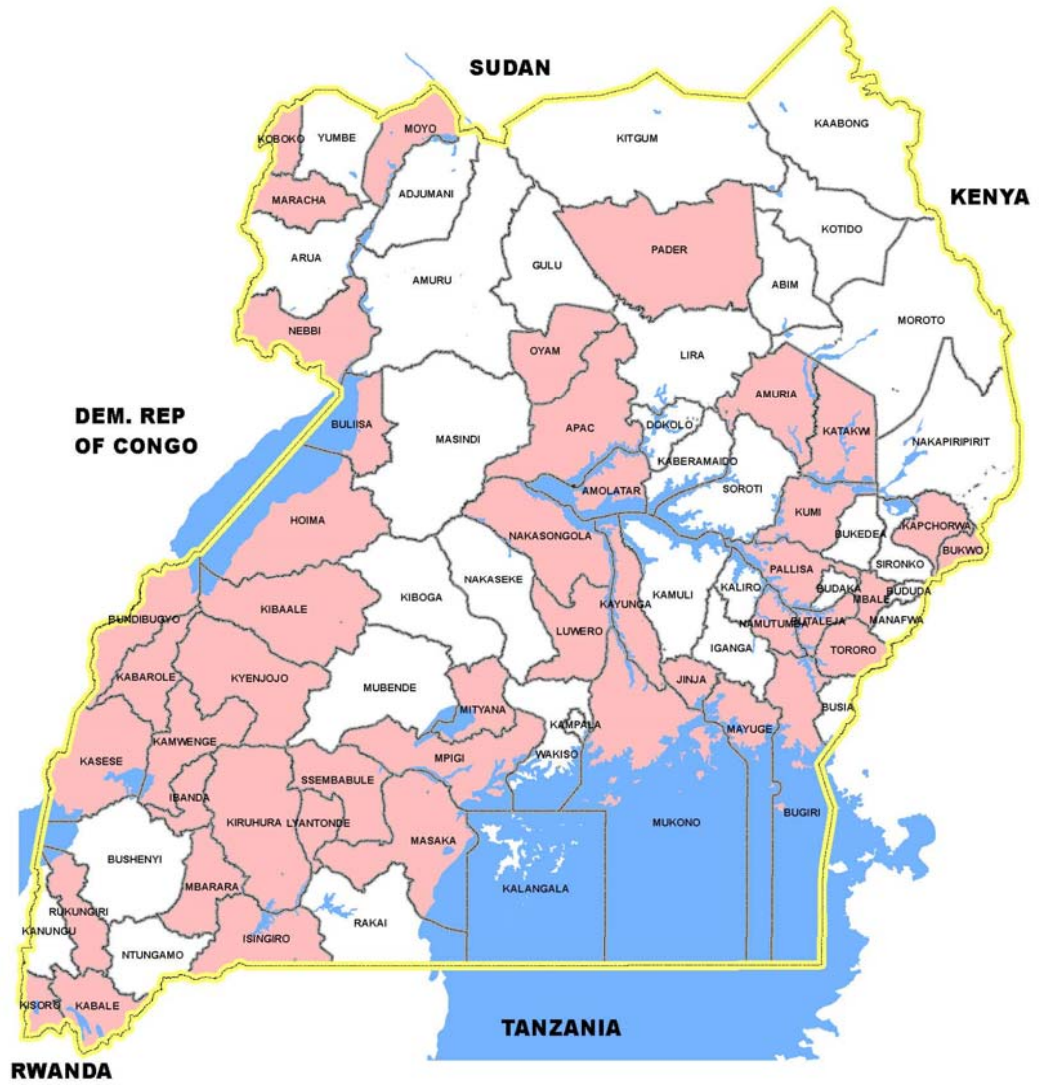
